Gas South Education Grants

\$50,000 is available to be disbursed to projects both big and small either need based or innovative. Grants will be awarded to one or more applicants based on merit. Grants may be requested for any amount between \$500-\$50,000 dollars. Collaborative projects benefiting a large number of students with results that can be replicated across grade level, school and/or cluster are strongly encouraged.

The 2022 application will be available online beginning January 5, 2022

Deadline to apply is February 28, 2022. Winners will be announced May 2022. Photo check awards will take place at the beginning of the 2022-2023 school year.

Application Questions:

- What need does this project address and who does it serve?

Requirements:

Successful proposals will meet the following criteria:

- Innovative or strengthens academics in one or more of curriculum areas doesn't have to be STEM
- Meets School Improvement Plan objectives
- Support college and career readiness for students
- Outcomes are measurable
- Success can be replicated within the school and across the district
- Resources are used wisely for greatest impact
- Proposal included budget details and notes additional sources of support

Narrative

1. Project Overview

- a) Brief Project Summary. Your project in 100 words or less.
- b) Description, Goals and Objectives. Address how this project falls under the curriculum areas of your school or how it is innovative? How it will strengthen education in your school or cluster. Give a summary of your project's goals and objectives.
- c) Estimated project timeline. Explain your estimated timeline for your project including implementation date, any milestones, and completion date.

2. Budget

Itemize project expenditures. If relevant, discuss sustainability of the project if there are future funding needs.

3. Communication
