Scholarship Eligibility Requirements:

- Applicant must be a resident of Mobile County Alabama or the 11 counties that make up the Atlanta region
- Applicant must attend a high school located in Mobile County Alabama or in the 11 counties that make up the Atlanta region
- Applicant must demonstrate financial need
- Applicant must be a high school senior in good standing
- Minimum unweighted GPA of 3.6 on a 4.0 scale
- Minimum score of 26 on the ACT; 1300 Reading and Math score on the SAT
- Applicant must be a U.S. citizen or have lawful immigration status in the U.S.
- Applicant must be planning to attend an accredited four-year college full-time
- Minimum Community Service and Extracurricular involvement
- Demonstrated leadership skills

Application Requirements:

- Two Letters of Recommendation from academic sources
- One Letter of Recommendation from a personal source
- Transcript
- Résumé
- 500 word essay that details why applicant is deserving of the scholarship and the impact it will have on their future and the future of their community.
- Parent/Guardian tax return from the last two years, and last three check stubs from all income sources
