WHY HEALTHCARE WORKERS NEED HELP TODAY

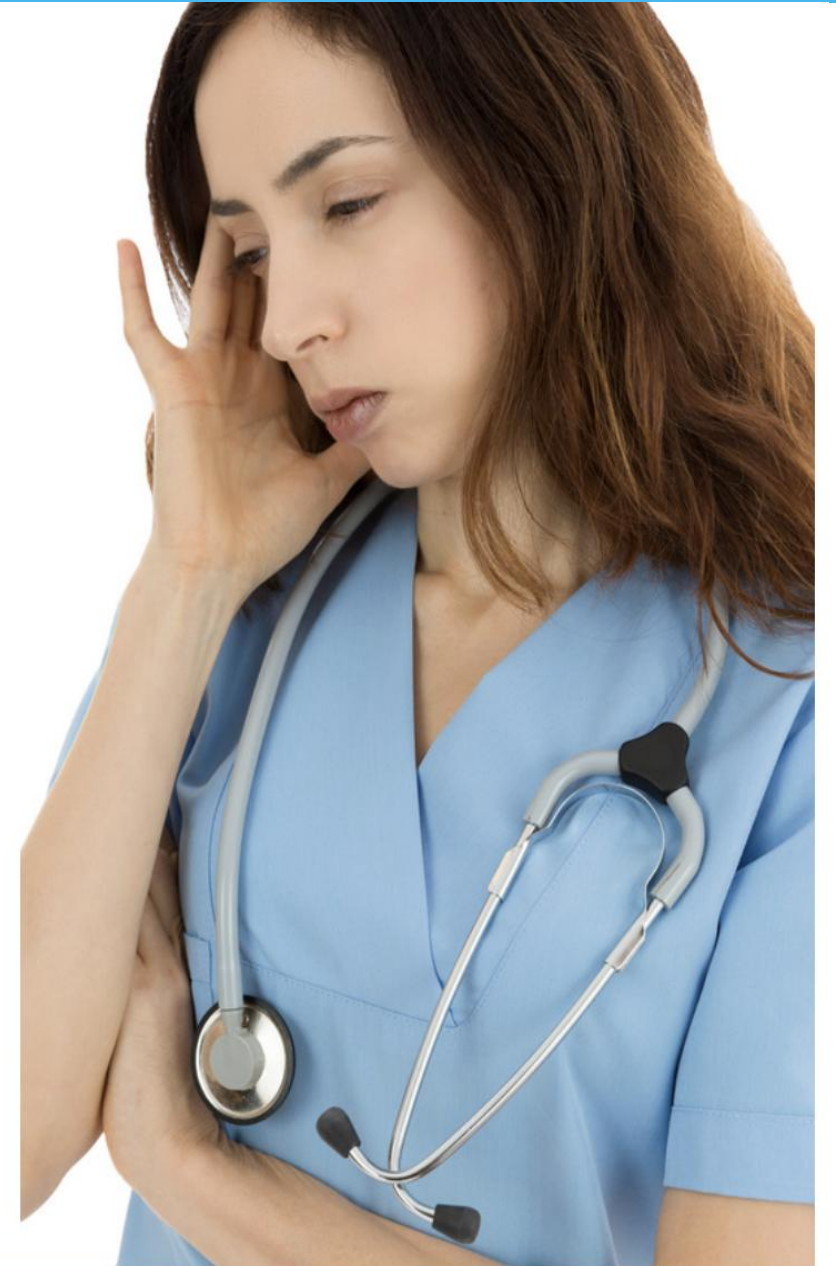
Healthcare professionals have dedicated their lives to keeping our community safe and healthy.

Mental Health America reports, that since the pandemic began, more than [93% of healthcare workers](#) suffer from stress and mental health issues, with Nurses reported significantly more depression, anxiety and stress. This has burdened our families, teams, and at times negatively impacted patient safety.

The COVID-19 pandemic revealed how much strain we are under and the true impact we have on our communities.

Many first responders and clinical support staff live below our nation's mean standard of living. The [American Journal of Public Health](#) found that 1.7 million female health care workers and their children lived in poverty.

In healthcare, we face a host of challenges, including trauma, workplace violence, and staffing shortages. Sustainability of the healthcare workforce is of utmost importance as we strive for stronger, healthier communities.

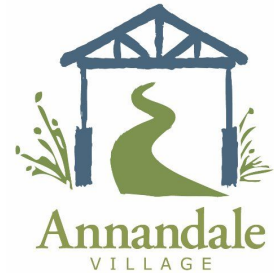
